Come out and tour the Old Stone Mill; especially if you have lived here your entire life. You won't believe the changes as wheat is once again being ground into flour just as it was 200 years ago.



The Old Stone Mill, a National Historic site, is a wonderful piece of history and at one time was the hub of the community. Grinding of the Ontario Heritage Red Fife Wheat started this year on May 19th, and will continue every Saturday throughout the summer. The wheat is grown locally by Chris Wooding of Ironwood Organics, Gananoque.

Flour from the Old Stone Mill is of extremely high quality and is for sale at the Mill. Four grades are available for sale; Fine, Bolted, Whole Grain, and Bran - all these result from a single grind; either not sorted (whole grain) or separated into different grades by gravity and screening.

If you would like a taste of homemade bread made from the Mill's Flour, you can stop by the Mill each Saturday morning until Labour Day weekend at 10:00 a.m. Plan to arrive early and you may be lucky enough to enjoy special treats like cinnamon buns or bagels made by local bread making expert, Louise Richards.
