Delta Park Becomes Holiday Destination

Just think of it.... An evening stroll or a wagon ride amidst trees and buildings that are all magically lit with holiday lights. If this interests you, then Lower Beverley Lake Park is the place for you this holiday season!



Launching on November 17th, Delta Park will be open for tours on five consecutive Saturday nights. More than 75,000 Christmas lights will adorn the trees and buildings throughout the park and will highlight various theme corners, a candy cane lane, a gingerbread house, a nativity scene, Santa's workshop and a miniature display of Delta's heritage buildings. Mr. and Mrs. Santa Claus will be on hand to receive those special wish lists, pose for photographs and give out holiday treats.

Wagon rides to the park will only be available from the United Church on ½ hour intervals starting at 5:00 p.m.

Patrons wishing to walk through the park may do so and park at the Village Boat Launch.

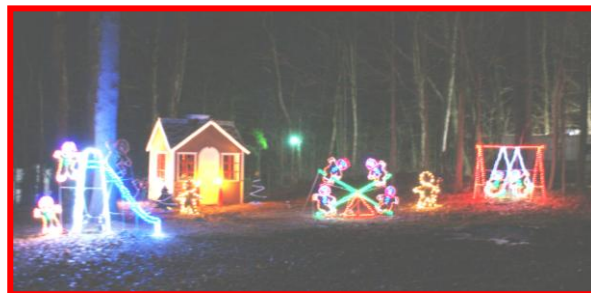
