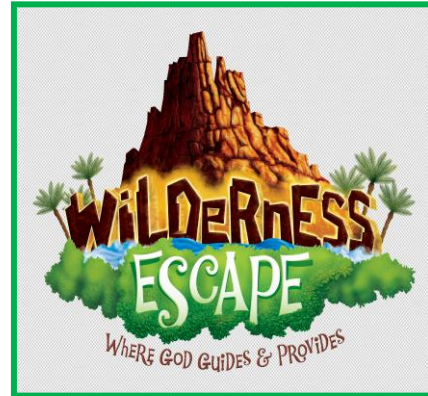

Looking to Dispose of Unwanted Materials?



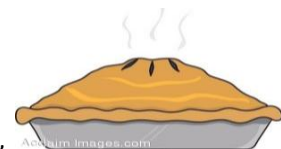

Milling Demonstrations will be held on Saturday, July 5th, 19th and August 2nd at 1:00 p.m. at which time fresh ground flour may be purchased.

The Mill Society has also partnered with the Gananoque Brewing Company who now uses the Red Fife Wheat that has been ground at the Mill in the production of their beer. The Gananoque Harvest Festival starts on Saturday, August 23rd with milling demonstrations followed by similar demonstrations every Friday and Saturday at 1:00 p.m. until September 20th.

Special plans are being made for an Evening of Entertainment at the Old Town Hall which will feature the musical talents of our summer students and the Annual Fundraising Dinner.
