Well, the official countdown is on to the summer of 2009! It hard to believe that we will finally be able to trade in our well used snow shovels for lawn mowers. The Management and Staff of Lower Beverley Lake Park are looking forward to the return of our seasonal camping friends next month.

#### **Christmas 2008**



It was great to see so many members of our camping family in attendance at our forth annual "Celebrating the Season" light festival in December. Approximately 4500 people visited the park to see the lights and figurines and to visit Santa's workshop for a cup of hot chocolate and a donut. We have since received many positive comments about our evenings in the park.

One of the new attractions offered in 2009 will be a miniature display of heritage buildings located within the Delta community. Don Paul and Brian Abrams completed the construction of 10 miniature replicas during the winter months with plans being put in place to expand the display yet again next winter.

#### **Operational Dates**

The park will be open to the public for camping between the dates of Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup> and Monday, October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2009. While Seasonal Campers may access the park to clean their lots/trailers prior to our opening day, over night stays are not permitted until May 8<sup>th</sup>. Vehicle access will be provided when weather and road conditions permit.



#### **2010 Rates**

During the March meeting of the Management Board, members passed By-Law # 2009-02 which established and now regulates the rates / fees for all sites / services during the 2010 season. Rates have been increased to reflect the ongoing increase in hydro, water and septic related expenses. The following rates will apply to next year's camping sites.

Non-Serviced Sites: \$ 927.00 + \$46.35 (5% GST) = \$ 973.35 15 amp Service: \$1467.50 + \$73.38 (5% GST) = \$1540.88 30 amp Service: \$1725.25 + \$86.26 (5% GST) = \$1811.51

# **Spring Projects**

Since the return of maintenance staff on March 16<sup>th</sup>, various projects have been completed within the park including the painting of the interior walls in the Gate House, Cottage 10/11, and the installation of new countertops, sinks and cubicle walls/doors in both washroom facilities at the Canteen and the Small Service Centre. The Canteen and Cottage 4 were completely renovated this year and received new windows, doors, light fixtures, decking, and ceiling/wall coverings.

In the fall, the Park Board submitted an application to an outside funding source for financial support with building additional docks in the bay at A36. Unfortunately, this application was not successful and as a result, we will not be able to add a new docking facility to the park this year.



#### **Spring Clean Up**

Just a reminder to those seasonal campers who will be in the park cleaning up their lots prior to opening day that any raked leaves need to be placed in a garbage bag and taken to the road for Maintenance staff to collect. Similarly, any waste should be dealt with in the same manner.

Any pre-season site clean up should NOT be carried out prior to May 1<sup>st</sup> as the roadways and grounds within the park are still very soft.
