The Hall of Fame Induction Dinner will be held at the Benson Hall on August 16th, 2014.

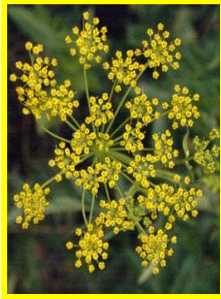
Campers' Recreation Committee

Wild Parsnip Warning



Along with the arrival of summer in Leeds & Grenville County comes an abundant new growth of Wild Parsnip. This invasive poisonous weed should be avoided as it poses a significant health risk to persons. An explosive growth of Wild Parsnip has resulted in many people suffering serious burns to the skin as a result of contact with sap from the plant.

Wild Parsnip can be found throughout Leeds and Grenville County within uncultivated land, roadside ditches, and parkland, nature trails, and sports fields as well as on and around residential properties.

Characteristics

- Height: 1 to 2 metres.
- Leaves: Pinnately compound with 2-5 pairs of opposite sharply toothed leaflets.
- Stems: Completely smooth and reddish/green in colour.
- Flowers: Yellow, umbrella shaped 10-20 cm across / similar in appearance to dill.

WHAT IF I COME INTO CONTACT WITH WILD PARSNIP?

1. Seek immediate shelter (exposure to sap makes human skin hypersensitive to sunlight).
2. Thoroughly wash exposed skin with soap and water.
3. If skin reacts, seek medical attention.
