Recycling Notice



Following recent changes to the municipal recycling program, campers are now able to recycle even more materials than in previous years.

A complete guide for the recycling of plastic/metals and paper/fibres has been included with this newsletter. We would ask that campers assist our community in diverting such waste from our landfill sites.

Seasonal Campers who do not wish to take their recycling directly to the bins, which are located in our Maintenance Storage Yard, are asked to put out their recycling on Sunday morning ONLY before 10:00 a.m. Please do not put out recyclable items during the week.

Campers are asked not to put their regular bagged garbage into the recycling bins.

Site Maintenance Reminder-Fire Pit Ashes

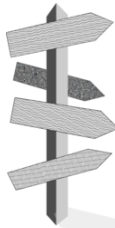

Abel Drive	Abel Stevens-Founder of Delta in 1790
Alexander Drive	Alexander Stevens, Proprietor of the Delta Centennial Carriage Factory
Bell Drive	William Bell-Store Keeper in 1850
Copeland Drive	Joel Copeland-Operated a Drug Store in 1892
Denaut Drive	Walter Denaut-Denaut Mansion, 1849
Eli Drive	Eli Holmes-Original owner of the Mess House, 1845
Flood Drive	Flood's Hotel, owned by Anthony Flood, was destroyed by fire in 1935
Godkin Drive	Eliza Jane Godkin Morris, School Teacher in 1900
Hastings Drive	Hastings Steele-last owner/operator of the Delta Mill in 1961
Irwin Drive	Lloyd Irwin, Prominent Delta Resident
Ira Drive	Ira Schofield was one of the original owners of the Mill
Jubilee Drive	Jubilee Block-built 1897 in honour of Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee
Knowlton Drive	John Knowlton constructed the Delta United Church in 1888 for \$3,000
Le Claire Drive	John Le Claire-Resident of Black Jack Island
Russell Drive	Olive Ruth Russell-Doctor of Psychology Harold Russell-Founder of the Delta Maple Festival Harrison Russell-Owner of Confederated Foods
