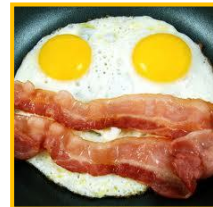

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**Before You Blow Your BREAKER!**

Take a minute and see how many amps you could be using in your trailer. It is surprising to see how fast the amps add up which causes your trailer breaker or the park breaker to trip. By tracking the amps needed for all of the electrical appliances in your trailer, you can help manage electrical use and save yourself the inconvenience of saying “My Electricity Went Out!”

Air Conditioner	13 - 17 amps	Refrigerator	5.7 amps
Water Heater	12.5 amps	Microwave	12.8 amps
Coffee Pot	9 amps	Toaster	10 amps
Hair Dryer	10 amps	Television	2 amps
Dirt Devil Vacuum	2 amps	Power Converter	2-3 amps
Electric Frying Pan	10 amps	Iron	10 amps
Food Processor	6 amps	Crock Pot	1.5 amps
Heating Pad	0.5 amps	1,100 Water Heater	10 amps

Be sure to check the breaker in your own trailer first before calling the Gate House.

Just a quick reminder that a message board has been installed on the outside wall of the Gate House. This board will be used to display any phone messages received for our seasonal clientele. Unless the message is of extreme importance, staff are unable to hand deliver the message to each site.

**WOOD SALES**

Campfire wood tickets are now available at the Gate House. Seasonal Campers purchasing wood through this offer will be issued two tickets: each for ½ of the delivery which can be submitted to Reception Staff at the Gate House when needed. This will save clutter and overcrowding on the site. Each face cord of wood (4’ x 8’ x 16”) will be delivered to a seasonal site for \$75.00.
