'Celebrating the Season'



Plans have been finalized and the lights are shining brightly as we now enjoy the sights and sounds of 'Celebrating the Season 2012'.

Launching on November 17th, the park will be open for tours on five consecutive Saturday nights between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. More than 75,000 Christmas lights will adorn the trees and buildings throughout the park and will highlight various theme corners, a candy cane lane, a gingerbread house, a nativity scene, Santa's workshop and a miniature display of Delta's heritage buildings. Mr. and Mrs. Santa Claus will be on hand to receive those special wish lists, pose for photographs and give out holiday treats.

Wagon rides to the park will only be available from the United Church on ½ hour intervals starting at 5:00 p.m. Patrons wishing to walk through the grounds may do so and park at the Village Boat Launch.

Winter Cottage Rentals



Cottage Units #10 and #11 are once again available for rent during the winter months at a rate of \$70 per day. Reservations may be made by completing the on-line reservation form which is located on the 'Rates' page of our website or by calling the Park at 613-928-2881 on Wednesday mornings.

The cottage, with a maximum occupancy of 6 people, has 2 bedrooms & a pull out sofa, electric heat, hot & cold running water, stove & fridge, various small appliances, cooking utensils, dishes and silverware. Bed linens are not provided.

Facility Upgrades

Since the park's closures for the season in October, several upgrades to our facilities have been completed which we hope will enhance the enjoyment of all our clientele.

- ✚ A new 'train' spring toy has been purchased and installed in the playground.
- ✚ Renovations have started within Cottage Unit #3.
- ✚ Several new picnic tables have been constructed.
- ✚ 30 trees were transplanted from our nursery to various locations within the park.
- ✚ Plans were approved for the construction of a storage building adjacent to the Arcade for the storage of supplies belonging to the Seasonal Campers' Recreation Committee.
- ✚ Electrical and water upgrades within the H and K Sections have not yet been completed. The Management Board is currently working with Hydro One and RW Electric of Kingston to develop a plan for the installation of three phase electrical services within the park. Once approved, contractors will be working in the park throughout the winter to complete all of the upgrades.
