Electrical Upgrades



In recent years, the Management Board completed electrical and water upgrades within the G and H Sections of the park. At that time, seasonal site holders were given the option of accepting the upgrade or remaining at the current level of service. With the needs of the camping community changing annually, we are no longer able to meet the increased demand for sites with 30 amp electrical and water services.

In preparation for the 2015 camping season, notice has been given that the sites within these sections which are still serviced with 15 amp services will be upgraded. Seasonal Campers impacted by this upgrade will have the option of remaining on the site with 30 amp services or relocating within the park to a site with 15 amp services.

Horseshoes

Congratulations are extended to Jim Fenlong and John Perrin for winning the top prize at the Bob Bradford Memorial Horseshoe Tournament which was held during Labour Day weekend.

Throughout the summer, horseshoe enthusiasts demonstrate their skills at games held every Saturday morning and at the various tournaments held on long weekend.

Vacant Sites

As outlined in Policy Statement # 10: Reservation and Transfer of Seasonal Camp Sites, an invitation to relocate shall be extended to all existing seasonal campers before any vacant sites are offered to the general public. Should any camper be interested in relocating to the vacant sites, please contact the Park Office in writing before November 1st specifically indicating which site you would like to move to and the reason behind the request to relocate. Anyone relocating will be required to do so prior to November 15th.

Several campers have already submitted vague notes regarding relocating sites. Please remember that these notes are not valid and that formal letters of request for specific sites must now be submitted stating the site requested. Letters that do not request a specific site cannot be processed. Sites being requested must be able to adequately accommodate your trailer
