Vacant Sites

As outlined in Policy Statement # 10: Reservation and Transfer of Seasonal Camp Sites, an invitation to relocate shall be extended to all existing seasonal campers before any vacant sites are offered to the general public. Should any camper be interested in relocating to the vacant sites, please contact the Park Office in writing before October 17th specifically indicating which site you would like to move to and the reason behind the request to relocate. Anyone approved for relocation will be notified and will be required to do so prior to November 1st.



Several campers have already submitted vague notes regarding relocating sites. Please remember that these notes are not valid and that formal letters of request for specific sites must now be submitted stating the site requested. Letters that do not request a specific site cannot be processed. Sites being requested must be able to adequately accommodate your trailer
