Your efforts have made a great improvement to the park. We truly appreciate the time, effort and skill that you put into making the park a more enjoyable space for everyone.

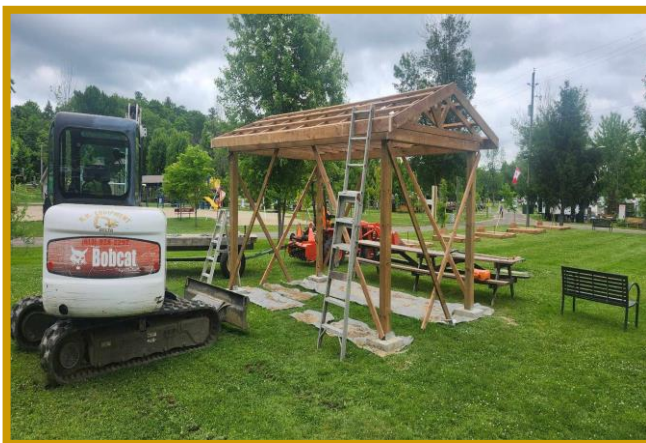

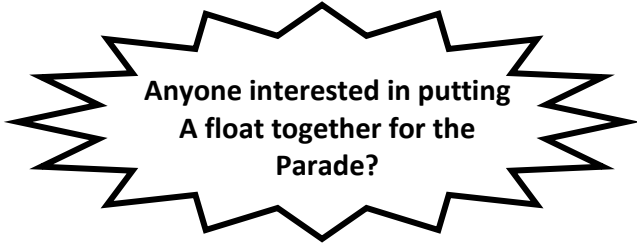

FIRE SAFETY TIPS

Starting your grill for the first time this year? Make sure all burner ports are free of rust or dirt and that the burner orifice is clear of dust and cobwebs. Check cylinder connections and hoses for leaks by brushing a 50/50 mix of liquid soap and water onto all connections and hoses. Rising bubbles when you turn on the valve indicate a leak. Tighten connections or repair the hose until there are no bubbles.

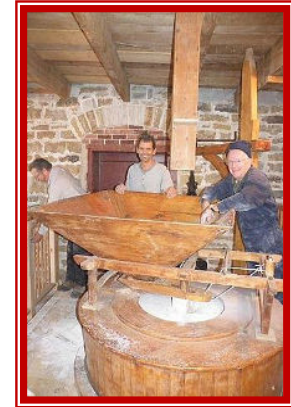

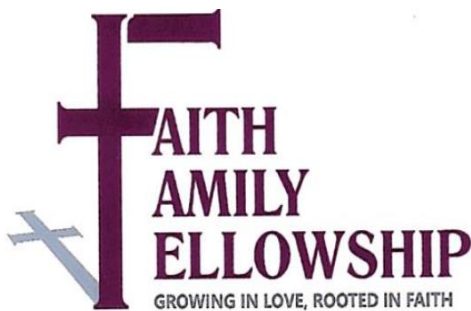
