# NOTICE

The Township of Rideau Lakes Fire Department has now imposed a

## **TOTAL BURN BAN ON ALL OPEN FIRES.**

It is an expectation that all clientele / users of facilities within Lower Beverley Lake Park will abide by said municipal regulations. While fire pits are provided as part of the campsite layout, fires are only permitted in conditions and during times as dictated by the municipal Burning By-Law.

**A TOTAL BURN BAN** means that all **OPEN AIR BURNING, BURN BARRELS; INCINERATORS OR CAMPFIRES OF ANY SIZE** are prohibited.

The registered site holder is responsible for the conduct of all people (family /visitors) on the site. In the event, the site holder or the occupants opts not to comply with the Burning Ban; the following actions may be taken:

- The Fire Department may impose a fine of \$500 upon the Site Holder in the event the campfire is maintained outside of the prescribed hours of the burning ban.  
Reference: Township of Rideau Lakes By-Law # 2005-70, Section 2.2 (k)
- Park staff will extinguish the campfire.
- Campsite / Cottage Reservations will be terminated, and the occupants will be requested to vacate the facilities without refund.

Campers should assume that the ban will remain in force until notification is received otherwise.
